Rockland Summer School courses are designed for students who failed a course or are recommended to attend summer school by Middle School administration. All classes are online with mandatory instruction/class time four days per week with a certificated teacher.

Registration will take place in the Guidance Office at Rockland High School office from 8:00 am – 3:00 PM daily, June 12th – June 30th. Forms are available online or in the Guidance office. Payment must be made at the time of registration in the form or cash or a **BANK CHECK OR MONEY ORDER payable to Town of Rockland – Summer School. No personal checks will be accepted.** The deadline is 3:00 p.m. on June 30th. **No refunds will be issued unless a course is cancelled.**

Classes: Students are required to attend their class daily during their scheduled time(s). Scheduled days and times will be filled on a first come, first served basis. Class size may be limited. Class time is facilitated by a certified teacher and serves as an opportunity for students to ask questions and gain guidance. Students may need to work on course work outside of scheduled class time to complete assignments.

Final exams: Final exams will be taken on the last day of class. Failure to take the final exam will result in an F for the course. No refunds will be issued for students who fail to take the final exam.

Attendance: Attendance is mandatory and students will be dropped from a course after their second missed session. Two tardies are considered one absence. **No refunds will be issued for students who are dropped due to non-attendance.**

Conduct: All school rules (including dress code) are enforced during summer school. Disruptions will not be tolerated and any student causing a disturbance will be dismissed from summer school. Tuition will not be refunded.

Materials: Students **must bring ear buds/headphones to class daily.** Please indicate on the registration form if you need headphones provided to you.

Out of district students must bring a copy of eligibility/permission from their school to enroll

Summer School Rules & Regulations - 2017

PURPOSE: The primary purpose of the Rockland Summer School Program is to provide remedial learning opportunities to students. Remedial Summer School is designed to help students who have maintained prescribed attendance standards and who have had difficulty in reaching minimal competency levels in required courses.

ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES: A student must have the approval of their school Administration to enroll in summer school. A student from out of district will need to have consent from their school to enroll in a Rockland Summer School course.

ATTENDANCE:

- A student is expected to attend all classes.
- A vacation is not an acceptable excuse for an absence.
- **If a student is absent from class more than twice, he/she may be dropped from the class.**
- Tardiness of greater than 10 minutes will be considered an absence.
- Three occurrences of tardiness of less than 10 minutes will equal an absence. No refund will be issued if a student is dropped due to non-attendance.

CONDUCT:

All school rules apply and will be enforced – to review the Rockland Middle School handbook, please visit: <http://www.rocklandschools.org/rmshandbook.html>.

Disruptions will not be tolerated and any student causing a disturbance may be dismissed from summer school. **NOTE: Cell phone use is not permitted in classrooms.** If a teacher observes a student using a phone, the teacher will take the phone and return it to the student at the end of class. If the problem persists, phones will be taken prior to the beginning of class and will be held by the Summer School coordinator; parents/guardians will be notified.

Any student dismissed from the program for behavior prior to completion of the course will not receive credit or reimbursement for the course.

FINAL EXAMS: Final exams will be taken on the last day of class. Failure to take the final exam will result in an F for the course. No refunds will be issued for a student who fails to take the final exam on the scheduled day.

GRADING: Summer school courses are graded on a Pass/Fail basis. Appropriate grade(s) and credit(s) for completed course work will be added to the student's permanent record card.
